

[56] for a protective order is denied, and Microsoft shall: immediately produce all materials responsive to Request No. 20 of Plaintiffs' First Joint Request for Production of Documents; make William Gates, III available for deposition testimony commencing August 12, 1998, for not less than two consecutive days, without prejudice to an application for relief under Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(c) if and when circumstances may warrant; and, within three (3) days of this Order, schedule dates for all remaining depositions noticed by plaintiffs; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that the motion [53] of the United States to file under seal certain exhibits is granted, and Exhibits A, E, and G to the memorandum of the United States and plaintiff States in support of the motion to compel discovery shall be filed and maintained under seal in accordance with Section H of the Protective Order; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that Microsoft's motion [55] to modify the May 27, 1998 Stipulation and Protective Order is held in abeyance; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that Microsoft's motion [24] to maintain under seal certain confidential documents is granted.
