PROPOSED CHANGES TO LOCAL RULES

The United States District Court for the District of Columbia approved the publication of the following proposed rule changes for notice and comment.

LCvR 7(b)

Within 14 days of the date of service or at such other time as the Court may direct, an opposing party shall serve and file a memorandum of points and authorities in opposition to the motion. If such a memorandum is not filed within the prescribed time, the Court may proceed to decide the motion and, unless it is one for summary judgment, may treat it as conceded.

Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 1.1 (b), the Court is required to advise that the proposed rule will be adopted unless modified or withdrawn by the Court after receiving comments from organized bar associations, members of the bar, and the public. Such comments must be made in writing by April 14, 2017 and should be addressed to John Aldock, Esq., Chairman, Advisory Committee on Local Rules, Goodwin Procter LLP, 901 New York Avenue, N.W; Washington, DC 20001.
