

Public and Media Advisory

Please be advised of the following arrangements for public and media access to the post-trial proceedings in *United States v. Google LLC, 20-cv-3010 (APM)*, and *State of Colorado v. Google LLC, 20-cv-3715 (APM)*, scheduled for May 2-3, 2024, in Courtroom 10.

The entrances to the E. Barrett Prettyman Courthouse and the William B. Bryant Annex ("the Courthouse") will be open to the public and media by 7:30 am.

Media Access at the Courthouse

- The District Court media room (Room 1206) will open at 8:00 am and will carry a live audio/video feed of the proceedings. A media room pass is required for entry:

 https://www.dcd.uscourts.gov/district-court-media-room. Pass applications will be available at the media room and may be completed on site.
- Seats in the media room will be first-come, first-served, and may be limited to one per organization, depending upon the level of interest. Media organizations that have at least one reporter with a long-term media room pass are guaranteed at least one media room seat.
- A minimum of 20 seats will be reserved for members of the media in Courtroom 10. Members of the media interested in a seat in Courtroom 10 should wait in line outside of the courtroom. Media pool seats may be arranged should the level of interest warrant.
- All electronic devices must be powered off while in Courtroom 10.

Public Access at the Courthouse

- Courtroom 24 will serve as an overflow courtroom and will be open for members of the public to observe a live audio/video feed of the proceedings. Seats in the overflow courtroom will be first-come, first-served. Courtroom 24 will open at 8:30 am.
- Limited seats also will be available for members of the public in Courtroom 10. Seating will be first come, first served. Members of the public interested in a seat in Courtroom 10 should wait in line outside of the courtroom.
- All electronic devices must be powered off while in the overflow courtroom or Courtroom 10.

Remote Access

media credentials, restricted entry to future hearings, denial of entry to future hearings, or any other
sanctions deemed necessary by the presiding Judge.
