**ORDERED** UCB S.A.'s Motion for a Scheduling Order is **GRANTED**. It is further hereby

**ORDERED** that the parties will follow the following schedule with respect to UCB S.A.'s motion to dismiss:

1. UCB S.A. will file a motion to dismiss for lack of personal jurisdiction and supporting memorandum of law detailing the bases for its motion in each of the forum states by April 9, 2001;


2. UCB S.A. will produce for deposition Jean Michel Denis, John Kelly, and if ordered by Special Master Pollak, Frank Coenen, as well as any other discovery ordered by the Special Master with respect to the personal jurisdiction of UCB S.A., no later than 7 days prior to May 9, 2001;

3. Plaintiffs will file their oppositions to UCB S.A.'s Motion to Dismiss by May 9, 2001;
