**-PROPOSED STIPULATED ORDER CONCERNING  
DEPOSITIONS OF AL HARAKA AND SCOT WILLIAMS**

WHEREAS, Al Haraka and Scot Williams, who were identified in defendants' trial witness list but were not previously deposed, are therefore subject to deposition, pursuant to the Court's May 7, 2002 Stipulated Order;

WHEREAS, the dates initially noticed by plaintiffs for the depositions of Messrs. Haraka and Williams are not convenient for them and the proposed alternative dates offered by defendants prior to the December 6, 2002 cut-off set forth in the Court's May 7, 2002 Stipulated Order are not convenient for plaintiffs; and

WHEREAS, the dates of December 10, 2002 and December 11, 2002 are agreeable to both plaintiffs and defendants;

UPON CONSIDERATION of the foregoing, it is hereby ORDERED that:

The December 6, 2002 cut-off set forth in the Court's May 7, 2002 Stipulated Order be relaxed for the sole purpose of permitting plaintiffs to take the depositions of Al Haraka and Scot Williams on December 10, 2002 and December 11, 2002, respectively.




