STIPULATED ORDER RE: PRETRIAL SCHEDULE

Whereas, the parties' objections to and counter deposition designations, as well as the parties' *in limine* motions, were filed on Friday, November 15, 2002;

Whereas, pursuant to the Court's September 10, 2002 Pretrial Order, the responses to the objections to and counter deposition designations were to be filed and served on Wednesday, November 27, 2002, and the oppositions to the parties' *in limine* motions were to be filed and served on Monday, December 2, 2002;


It is hereby stipulated and agreed by the undersigned that:




