Reappointment of Incumbent Magistrate Judge

The current term of United States Magistrate Judge G. Michael Harvey is due to expire February 12, 2023.

The duties of a Magistrate Judge in this Court are demanding and include:

- in criminal matters, presiding over most preliminary proceedings, trials and disposition of misdemeanor cases, and various pretrial and evidentiary proceedings upon referral or delegation from a District Judge; and reviewing and determining government applications for surveillance and warrants; and
- (2) in civil matters, presiding over trials and other dispositions, upon consent of the litigants; overseeing pretrial discovery; and conducting mediations.

The United States District Court is required to establish a panel of citizens when considering the reappointment of an incumbent Magistrate Judge. The Court has established a Merit Selection Panel, with appointment effective August 1, 2022, to consider the reappointment of Magistrate Judge Harvey to a new eight-year term.
