ORDERED that lists of docket numbers, with some associated docket information, for (A) applications filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2703(d); (B) applications filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2703(a)—(c)(1)(A) and/or Rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure; (C) applications filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3512 ("Foreign requests for assistance in criminal investigations and prosecutions"); (D) applications for pen registers and trap and trace devices ("PR/TT") filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3122 and 3123; and (E) applications for warrants to seize property subject to forfeiture filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 981–82, 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), 21 U.S.C. §§ 853, 880, and other authority, set out in Attachments A, B, C, D, and E respectively, which applications were filed by the USAO-DC between October 1, 2019 and

March 31, 2020, shall be unsealed; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court make publicly accessible this Standing Order with attachments on the appropriate location of this Court's website.
