IN RE RESUMPTION OF NATURALIZATION AND ADMISSIONS CEREMONIES FOLLOWING RESTORATION OF APPROPRIATIONS

ORDER

On October 20, 2025, this Court suspended naturalization ceremonies and in-person attorney-admissions ceremonies to avoid a violation of the Antideficiency Act during the recent government shutdown. See Standing Order No. 25-56, In Re Suspension of Naturalization and Admissions

Ceremonies During Government Shutdown, October 20, 2025 (JEB). Government-wide appropriations were restored on November 12, 2025. Accordingly,

- Naturalization Ceremonies. The authority conferred on the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services by Standing Order 25-56 is terminated effective November 24, 2025.
 Naturalization ceremonies shall resume on the regular schedule; and
- 2. <u>Attorney-Admission Ceremonies</u>. In-person attorney-admissions ceremonies shall resume on the regular schedule. Further information, including the monthly deadlines for submission of petitions for admission, may be found on the Court's website.
