STANDING ORDER NO. 2
IN RE: *REHAIF V. UNITED STATES*, 588 U.S. ____, 139 S. Ct. 2191 (2019)

This Standing Order supplements and modifies the Standing Order issued by this Court on June 18, 2020 ("Standing Order") concerning *Rehaif v. United States*, 588 U.S. _____, 139 S. Ct. 2191 (2019).

Pursuant to the original Standing Order, this Court appointed the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the District of Columbia to represent any defendant previously determined to have been entitled to appointment of counsel, or who is now indigent, to determine whether that defendant may be eligible for relief pursuant to the United States Supreme Court's decision in *Rehaif*, and to file any such motions for relief by June 22, 2020. The Standing Order also authorized the United States Probation Office of the District of Columbia to disclose Presentence Investigation Reports, Judgments, and Statements of Reasons, including in sealed cases, to the Office of the Federal Public Defender and to Office of the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia. The Standing Order further directed that the United States would have 120 days, or until October 20, 2020, to submit a response to any *Rehaif*-related motion; that the defendant would have 60 days to submit a reply to the government's response; and that requests for continuances would be considered on a case-by-case basis.

After consultation with the Office of the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia and the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the District of Columbia regarding the Section 2255 motions filed on June 22, 2020 by the Federal Public Defender for the District of Columbia, and in view of the extensive compassionate release litigation that the parties have been engaged in as a result of the Coronavirus pandemic, the Court supplements and modifies its

June 18, 2020 Standing Order as indicated below. In all other respects, the original Standing

Order remains in full force and effect.

The United States will have up to an additional 60 days, or until December 21, 2020, to

file a response to the *Rehaif* motions identified in Exhibit A to this Order and will have up to an

additional 100 days, or until January 28, 2021, to file a response to the Rehaif motions identified

in Exhibit B to this Order. The Federal Public Defender will have 60 days from the date of the

United States' response to file a reply, if any. In addition, the Federal Public Defender may file a

supplement by December 21, 2020, in any of the cases identified in Exhibit A, and may file a

supplement in any of the cases identified in Exhibit B. In any case in which the Federal Public

Defender files such a supplement, the United States and the Federal Public Defender will confer

and present a proposed joint scheduling order to the Court to govern future filings. Any request

for a continuance will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

This Order is effective immediately.
