**STANDING ORDER 19-17**

As contemplated by the Memorandum of Understanding Regarding Electronic Filing of Certain Sealed Applications and Orders, entered into by the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia and the Criminal Division of the U.S. Department of Justice (“DOJ-CR”) on May 31, 2018, and most recently updated on February 26, 2019, and following consultation with the Clerk’s Office of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia and the DOJ-CR, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that a list of docket numbers, with limited associated docket information, for sealed applications filed between **April 1, 2018 and September 30, 2018** by the Office of International Affairs (“OIA”) of DOJ-CR, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3512 (“Foreign requests for assistance in criminal investigations and prosecutions”), for orders under 18 U.S.C. § 2703(d), which list is set out in **Attachment A**, shall be unsealed. *See In re Leopold to Unseal Certain Elec. Surveillance Apps. & Orders*, 33 F. Supp. 3d 61, 97 (D.D.C. 2018) (citing *United States v. Hubbard*, 650 F.2d 293 (D.C. Cir. 1980)); and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Clerk of the Court make publicly accessible this Standing Order with attachment on the appropriate location of this Court's website.
