**Complaints Against Judges**

~~The Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980, Title 28 U.S.C. § 372(e)351(a),~~ authorizes the filing of that complaints against United States circuit, district, bankruptcy, and magistrate judges who have “engaged in conduct prejudicial to the effective, and expeditious administration of the business of the courts” or who are “unable to discharge all the duties of office by reason of mental or physical disability.” ~~may be submitted to a judicial committee for review.~~
